## **Early Voting A Big Deal** At LWR Town Hall

**I** presidential election in progress – or that some company had leased out the Town Hall and was holding a promotional give-away program inside. You might even have been taken aback by the sheer numbers of cars in the Town Hall parking lot, even on days when the Town Hall was not "open for business." But, no, it was just the early voting push for this year's midterm general election. This year, early voting was a really big deal in Lakewood Ranch!

All you had to do to figure that something major was afoot was to drive by Lakewood Ranch Town Hall. There were political signs all over the place - signs lining the sidewalks around the Town Hall, signs being carried by folks trying to promote their candidate or their particular amendment position, and signs posted on the tents set up by the various political parties to shelter their respective promoters

and supporters. The Democrat Party had one such tent set up, while the Republicans had two: one for the Republican Party of Manatee County itself, and one for a group promoting a re-election bid for President Trump in 2020. This group was asking for donations and, for a \$15 donation, the donor received a Trump 2020 T-shirt. The shirts featured well-known Trump slogans such as "Build the Wall" and "Drain the Swamp."

The popularity of early voting has increased in the years since its inception, and Lakewood Ranch's Town Hall has become one of the more active early voting locations in Manatee County. It scored the highest number of early voters in the County in the recent primary election, so it is perhaps no surprise that there were throngs of voters who lined up ... even lining up out the door and into the parking area of the Town Hall to cast their ballots.

I discussed the aspects of early voting with two women in the parking lot of the Town Hall. One woman, Kathy Lane, said that she was very happy that early voting was possible, and said that she thought that the voting was going very well. Her friend, Brenda Kahn, who had accompanied her to the Town Hall, commented that she had actually voted by mail, but that she thought that early voting was a great idea, and noted that people were even bringing their dogs with them into the Town Hall to accompany them while they voted!

As for the opinions and reasons why the folks carrying signs in front of the Lakewood Ranch Town Hall were spending their time there, opinions varied.

One school board candidate touted his experience as a teacher and administrator. Another commented that, in his opinion, the Republican Party was the only party able to fix the education system. One of the Democrat Party folks noted that, according to him, a lot of people who had formerly voted Republican had come by and told him that they had "voted Democrat for the first time in their lives." The folks at the Republican Party booth told me that their main focus was on the current strength of the economy.

Then there were the signs carried by supporters of various amendments, such as the proposed amendment to ban dog racing (No. 13 on the ballot), and the proposed amendment to restore voting rights to prisoners who had served their sentences, including parole and probation (No. 4 on the ballot).

Early voting in Manatee County differs from g "normal" voting in that there are, at this time,





## Waterside Place In Lakewood Ranch Breaks Ground

Groundbreaking for the much-anticipated Waterside Place commenced Oct. 4, with more than 150 in attendance, including representatives of the government, school board, and the business community. The future lakefront town center, lo-

cated south of University Parkway and east of I-75, will feature shops, restaurants, office space, The Players Centre for Performing Arts and Waterside Park, an eight-acre peninsular park.

Waterside Place will be the centerpiece of Lakewood Ranch Waterside, the Ranch's first residential development in Sarasota County. Completion of the Schroeder-Manatee Ranch project is expected in mid-2020. Construction is not being phased; Willis Smith will build the entire commercial portion at one time.

Although the specific businesses cannot be named at this point, letters of intent have been signed by such businesses as nail and hair salons, a yoga studio, gym, travel agency, a women's boutique, and both in-line and free-standing restaurants, according to Kirk Boylston, president of LWR Commercial.

"Waterside Place presented a unique opportunity to create a mixed-use project that has a significant amount of waterfront restaurants, shops and office space," Boylston said. "We have spent almost two years in planning and design to make this a special place for our residents and expect it to be a regional destination. There will be a number of open gathering spaces, parks, and a marina located directly on the waterfront, which will make Waterside Place a setting unlike any other retail area in the region. It isn't just a place to go shop or dine, but a place to hang out, relax and enjoy the surroundings."

Another exciting component of Waterside Place will be the Waterside Place Apartments by Davis Development. Scheduled to break ground at the end of 2018, Davis will deliver more than 800 units to the town center (including 22 rental townhomes). This will enhance



the vitality of the town center with day shoppers and diners.

Home sales at Lakewood Ranch Waterside are brisk; more than 100 homes have been sold since the first builder opened its doors just over a year ago. There are cur-

rently four home builders in two villages in Waterside: Homes by Towne, Arthur Rutenberg, and Lee Wethington in LakeHouse Cove, and Pulte in Shoreview. Many residents cited Waterside Place and its offerings as an incentive to buy in the village.

"Living in a brand-new community within the well-established amenities of Lakewood Ranch is ideal," said Lakewood Ranch Waterside resident Mike Collins. "We are particularly excited about lakeside 'wining and dining' in the new Waterside Place."

When Waterside is finished, it will feature 12 compact, walkable neighborhoods connected to each other and to Waterside Place via trails and waterways. Built around seven lakes, the community has more than 20 miles of shoreline and acres of nature preserves. Waterside Place will also feature a marina and water taxi.

"We want this to be a place where fun and entertainment are embraced," Boylston said. "Our leasing efforts are focused on bringing in great food, craft beer and cocktails, music, entertainment and other elements that create a place that is fun to be at, where people will want to return to frequently. We want this to be the place in our region where everyone goes to hang out with friends and family."

The construction of Lakewood Ranch Waterside included the added benefit of much-needed regional infrastructure, including the extension of Lorraine Road as a four-lane thoroughfare to Fruitville Road, which was complete in September of 2017, updates to Deer Drive, and the extension of Lakewood Ranch Boulevard to Fruitville Road, which began in July of this year.

only five designated polling places for early voting in Manatee County: The Lakewood Ranch Town Hall, the Manatee County Utilities offices on Bradenton's west side, the Palmetto Library, the Rocky Bluff Library in the Ellenton/Parrish area, and the Supervisor of Elections Office in central Bradenton.

During the early voting period, which took place this year between Oct. 24 and Nov. 3 in Manatee County, voters could cast their ballots at any of the early voting locations.

After early voting closed, if they still had not voted, voters were required to go to their normally designated precinct to vote on Nov. 6.

One of the reasons why so many residents chose to use early voting would appear to be the fact that this year's general election ballot contained so many items, from the usual major offices of governor, senator, congressional and state-




wide office positions, to a total of 12 proposed constitutional amendments to the Florida's cor stitution. Then there were the judgeships, count commission seats, school board seat, etc.

#### 10 FUN FACTS FROM SARASOTA POLO:


- 1) It takes a minimum of 60 polo ponies to play one regulation polo match. Each of the eight polo players ride six to eight ponies per match. Additionally, there are two mounted umpires, each of whom ride two ponies per match, bringing the total to more than sixty polo ponies!
- 2) The game lasts approximately two hours and consists of six, seven-and-a-half-minute "chukkers," between which players change mounts. Each player will bring one pony for each chukker and one or two spare ponies that wait on the sidelines in case a player's pony gets tired. You may enjoy watching the action at the sideline on the Southwest end of the field, as riders quickly get off and on their mounts between chukkers. Think of a NASCAR race car visiting the pit – minus the loud engines!




- 3) The Sarasota Polo Club, established in 1991, was the first development in Lakewood Ranch.
- 4) A polo field is 10 acres in size you can fit nine football fields inside of one polo field. A regulation-sized polo field is larger than any other regulation-sized sporting field played today. Don't worry, you won't miss the thundering of 10, 1,200-lb. ponies with their riders across a flat open polo field, but do pay attention; the polo ball reaches 110 mph at full velocity. You may also wish to bring a pair of field glasses in order to be able to always see the action up close.

Next we partook of a hot selection of hibachi cooked shrimp and scallops, served with fried

Here again, the food did not disappoint. The shrimp were great, and the scallops were large -about two inches in diameter, sliced to thinner sections, and cooked to perfection. Our combination included soup, a salad, and veggies that were cooked and served along with the scallops and shrimp.

Altogether, this represented a very satisfying meal, and I look forward to returning to Mizu Sushi and Hibachi Express for another Japanese dining experience.

The menu at Mizu is very long, with all sorts of possibilities. Their cooked appetizers include things like shrimp teriyaki, and deep-fried softshell crab, along with edamame for veggie

From the sushi bar, the diner can select appetizers such as octopus marinated with vinegar sauce, or thinly sliced yellowtail tuna garnished with cilantro and jalapenos, in a spicy

stand about 15.3 hands and weigh about 1,200 pounds. One 'hand' equals four inches. For scale, a Shetland pony stands about 14.2 hands and weighs 450 pounds. On the other end of the scale, a Clydesdale horse stands 19 hands and weighs 2,000 pounds! You will meet our Clydesdales during our half-time activities.

7) Tailgating is one of polo's most favored pastimes. Both food and drink are available onsite. Pimm's Cup – a drink made from dry gin liqueur, fruit juices and spices mixed with lemon-lime soda, cucumber and lemon slices - is polo's official drink. Try one at our Clubhouse

8) Polo must be played right-handed in order to prevent head-on collisions.

9) Each team consists of four mounted players, each with a different role. Player number three is the tactical leader, usually wielding the highest handicap and playing both offense and

10) During half-time, spectators are invited onto the field to participate in a polo tradition called "divot-stomping." Divot-stomping at halftime (think Pretty Woman) is not just for show.



Polo ponies create four divots on the field with almost every step. Divot stomping is actually a very important crowd activity, as it does genuinely restore the field for play. When you see a big chunk of grass missing, push it over with your foot and firmly pat it down. A word of advice, avoid the "steaming divots."
